Camping at Philippi

SEASON: The park is open annually from May 15th-September 15th (these dates may change slightly per season).

Getting there: The park is **ONLY** accessible by boat. The closest boat launch is Le Page Boat Ramp. You MUST pay for parking at Le Page Boat Ramp (this is NOT included in our fee structure). After launching head up the John Day River for about 1 mile- you can't miss it!

Docking: There are TWO docks at Philippi Park. Both are open to the public during the season.

Campsites: There are about 30 campsites available. ALL are first-come-first-serve. To make reservations contact Opal Foundation directly.

Amenities: Philippi Park features restrooms and warm showers that are available to campers and day users. There is also potable water at the restrooms.

Upon Arrival: We ask that you check in with camp hosts upon arrival. If there are no camp hosts on site, please use our fee structure and boxes by each boat dock to make your donation.

Garbage: There are NO GARBAGE CANS at Philippi Park. You must PACK OUT what you pack in. The nearest dumpsters are located at Le Page Boat Ramp.

Philippi Park Campground

Philippi Park is a boat-inonly campground on the John Day River. It's truly a little oasis: covered in green grass and surround by desert canyons.

Getting there:

To access Philippi use **exit 114** for Le Page Park off I-84. From there, you can launch your boat and head up the John Day River for about one mile.



Philippi Fee Structure

\$35 per night per campsite. One campsite includes:

2 tents 1 picnic table 1 boat



Additional tents, picnic tables and boats are considered a second campsite. Fees should be paid in deposit box or to camp host upon arrival.

Campsite Rules

- No fires
- Dogs must remain on a leash
- Quiet hours from 10PM-8AM
- No firearms
- Camping is limited to 14 days in any 30 day window
- MUST pack out what you pack in
